MEEDER OUTSTANDING SERVICE AWARD:

As we approach our mid-year timeframe SFBSTC is requesting your nomination for the Meeder Outstanding Service Award. Following our guidelines described below, submit your nominations to our SFBSTC Secretary, Linda Bartolotta (Secretary@sfbstc.org) by August 30, 2021.

This is an award specifically designated to honor those members whose contributions are so important to the success of any dog club and/or to the breed itself. An eligible member that receives a nomination can hold membership designation of Regular, Associate, or honorary status.)

Members holding an Office, Directorship or Committee Chair are eligible to receive the Award.

The SFBSTC may at its discretion, offer more than one award each year providing that the multiple awards are given for the same outstanding service to the Club and/or to the breed.)

Each year the Board of Directors of the SFBSTC shall solicit nominations from the membership for the Outstanding Service Award. Nominations shall be in written form (including e-mail) outlining the nominee's outstanding service and submitted to the Club Secretary.

Nominations must be received before the last scheduled Board meeting prior the Specialty.

The Board, acting as a selection committee, shall consider all nominations that have been received by the Club's Secretary. The name of the member selected by the Board shall be kept secret until the award is given at the Specialty Banquet. To preserve the integrity of the Outstanding Service Award, the Board reserves the right to forego giving the Award in any one calendar year.

MEDALLION AWARDS:

The SFBSTC offers the following Medallion Awards:

CHAMPIONSHIP - PERFORMANCE - GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP

Medallions will be awarded at the SFBSTC Specialty Banquet or at the Annual Meeting. Wins must be earned extending June 1^{st} of the previous year through May 31^{st} of the current year at AKC shows.

• BRONZE CHAMPIONSHIP MEDALLION-

The Championship Medallion is awarded for a Scottish Terrier, owned by SFBSTC members only, who attains a conformation championship. When there is a co-owner, the primary owner must be a member of the SFBSTC. This award must be requested from the Secretary in writing by the owner of the dog with copy of title no later than September 30th. One medallion will be awarded per dog.

Additional medallions for registered co-owners may be purchased, cost to be determined by the Board of Directors.

PEWTER PERFORMANCE MEDALLION-

This medallion is awarded for a Scottish Terrier, owned by SFBSTC members only, who attains an AKC Title in Obedience, Tracking, Earthdog, Agility, Rally, Therapy, Scent Work or Barn Hunt as published in the AKC Gazette/Awards. This award must be requested from the Secretary in writing by the owner of the dog with copy of AKC title no later than September 30th. One medallion will be awarded per dog.

Additional medallions for registered co-owners may be purchased, cost to be determined by the Board of Directors.

GOLD GRAND CHAMPION MEDALLIONS-

The Grand Champion Medallion is awarded for a Scottish Terrier, owned by SFBSTC members only, who attains a conformation Grand championship. When there is a coowner, the primary owner must be a member of the SFBSTC. This award must be requested from the Secretary in writing by the owner of the dog with copy of AKC title no later than September 30th. One medallion will be awarded per dog. Additional medallions for registered co-owners may be purchased, cost to be determined by the Board of Directors.

This past quarter has been quiet, as to be expected while states, counties, and communities relax their COVID-19 restrictions.

I have sent the SFBSTC Board a copy of our governing documents to review, and then to learn if updates are needed.

Scent Work Achievements

Meet Cooper



Cooper, J-Mar's Rally Car, qualified in 3 searches on Saturday June 5th at the Mensona Kennel Club AKC Scentwork Trial in Petaluma. This was Cooper's first trial.

He qualified in Novice Interior, Novice Exterior, and Novice Containers. To earn the actual title he will need to qualify two more times in each area for a total of three qualifying searches. Novice AKC Scentwork classes have the dogs search for a hidden q-tip with birch scent. Novice level searches have one hide that is placed in a room inside a building for Interior, one hide placed in an outside area for Exterior, and one hide placed inside one of 10 cardboard boxes for Containers. The dog must "alert" on the location of the hide at which point the handler tells the judge where the dog has found it. The dogs work independently with almost no guidance from the handler. Cooper will look at me when he has found the hide. The

dogs are rewarded with a food treat when they are successful.

While there are ribbons for first through fourth place based on how quickly the dog finds the hide, in performance events we covet the green qualifying ribbons.

As you can tell from the photo Cooper loves scentwork. He also loves the treats!
